Introduction

Each poem is like a short, cosy and sensitive childhood tale, where one would like to live for a moment. And to make us linger a little longer, the artist Marija Smirnovaitė has created enchanting images.

Goal. To increase the number of pupils reading.

Objectives:

1. Developing positive attitudes towards reading.
2. Strengthening students' reading skills.
3. Developing artistic abilities.
4. Formation of an attitude towards nature.

Methods, techniques and tools

The author of the poetry collection is introduced.

It is noted that the author has been awarded prizes for poetry collections.

"What the Bumblebee Thought" was shortlisted for the 2020 Children's Book of the Year.

The poet's poems are like a short, sensitive childhood tale that makes you want to live in it for a while.

The artist Marija Smirnovaitė, who has created enchanting images, is introduced.

Reading aloud (pupils read aloud poems from the collection "What the bumblebee thought").

Question House (pupils ask each other questions).

Group work. Find information about bumblebees and prepare slides.

Presentation of the prepared slides.

Question maze (the librarian asks the questions).

Draw what you liked most, what you remembered.

Exhibition of drawings.
