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## **Reading challenge "Summer with a book"**

"The Summer with a Book Reading Challenge is organised by the Association of County Public Libraries, the Association of Lithuanian Municipal Public Libraries and the Lithuanian Ministry of Culture.

### **Goal.**

To get more pupils reading fiction and non-fiction than now.

### **Objectives:**

1. to develop a positive attitude towards reading.
2. To create an environment that promotes reading and ensures its accessibility.
3. Strengthen pupils' reading skills.

### **Introduction**

Students are introduced to the challenge and encouraged to participate.

Challenge tasks are provided.

2021 Reading Challenge tasks:

Read a detective book.

Read a book with a title of at least 4 words.

Read a book that has won a literary prize.

Read a book published in the last millennium.

Read a funny book.

## **Methods, techniques and tools**

The prizes we will receive after completing all the tasks are presented.

The school library is registered as a participant.

Students who accept the challenge sign up.

The librarian helps to choose the books to complete the challenge.

Books are read during the summer according to the challenge.

We take photos with the books we are reading in a beautiful summer environment and send them to the librarian.

In the autumn we choose the most artistic photos.

We discuss how we managed to overcome the challenge.

Those who complete the challenge receive a diploma, a prize and a sweet gift from the librarian.

Those who did not complete the challenge receive a diploma, which proves that they took part in the challenge but fell a little short.
