

#### Creative contests

"Alma littera" publishing house organizes two literary contests for writers/illustrators:

- Since 2014 contest to create books for teenagers (main prize 2900 Eur).
- Since 2021 contest to create books for 0-12 y.o. children (main prize 2900 Eur).

### READING PROMOTION



• Non-governmental organizations - associations, foundations, other NGOs.

#### Libraries

- National library, district libraries, regional libraries, city libraries, specialized libraries (for people with visual impairment).
- Special reading rooms for children or entire children literature departments.
- National or local reading promotion campaigns/programs.

#### Book fairs at district libraries

 Klaipėda district's leva Simonaitytė public library – organizes 6 years.

Šiauliai district's Povilas Višinskis public library – organizes 9 years


#### IBBY Lithuania (www.ibbylietuva.lt)

 Organizes International Children's Book Day celebration (April 2nd), during which the most notable children's book authors and illustrators are awarded and the previous year in children's book world discussed.

• Publishes quarterly magazine "Rubinaitis" about children's books for teachers, librarians, literary researchers, writers, illustrators, publishers,






# Charity Foundation "Educating Children" (www.svieskimevaikus.lt)

- Controversial, political.
- Organizes national children's literature contest. Publishes the books of the winners (3 first places) in large numbers (13k) and gives them as gifts to libraries.







# Reading promotion program "Children's World" (www.vaikuzeme.lt)

- Working with children in different contexts family, school, diaspora communities.
- Working with children literature industry (authors, publishers, libraries, other organizations).
- Working with wider educational and cultural community.



#### Tiny books

• <u>www.tinybooks.eu</u> – collaboration project between 36 authors from LT, LV, EE. Result – 18 tiny books on different human rights topics.
